Schools/Early Childhood Services (ECS)	Family Support for Children with Disabilities (FSCD)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Program Unit Funding (PUF) is available to approved ECS operators for young children from 2½ to age 6. These children have been assessed with a severe disability/delay. • FSCD and PUF provide integrated programming and specialized services for eligible preschool children with severe disabilities and their families through the PUF/FSCD Common Approach. • Every student or ECS child who is identified with special education needs must have an individualized program plan (IPP). Schools put a learning team in place to provide consultation, planning, and problem solving related to programming for students with special education needs. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FSCD supports are available to families of children with disabilities. • Work with youth and families on transitioning to adulthood and coordinating access to adult programs.
